These changes have to be brought into effect to ensure we continue to meet our production schedule and deliver our vans on time to customers.

This will not affect anybody who has already ordered a van through us and all other customisation options will remain unchanged”.

FROM THE WARRANTY MANAGER:

As you know manufacturers everywhere are still having a problem obtaining parts for most everything and we are no exception. However we are better off that car manufacturers who, in most cases are having to wait for nearly a year to obtain the smallest of parts.

Our production area is full steam ahead despite Covid interruptions and in the area of warranty claims we managing to keep up to date where possible, so please bear with us in these difficult times.

Please remember if you have a warranty claim there is provision on the Royal Flair web site to lodge you warranty claim and this will help expedite it rather than trying to call us on the phone. Also when you take delivery of your new van and take it home, do NOT plug power leads into 240V, otherwise you could cause damage, We suggest you purchase an amphibian power protector.
