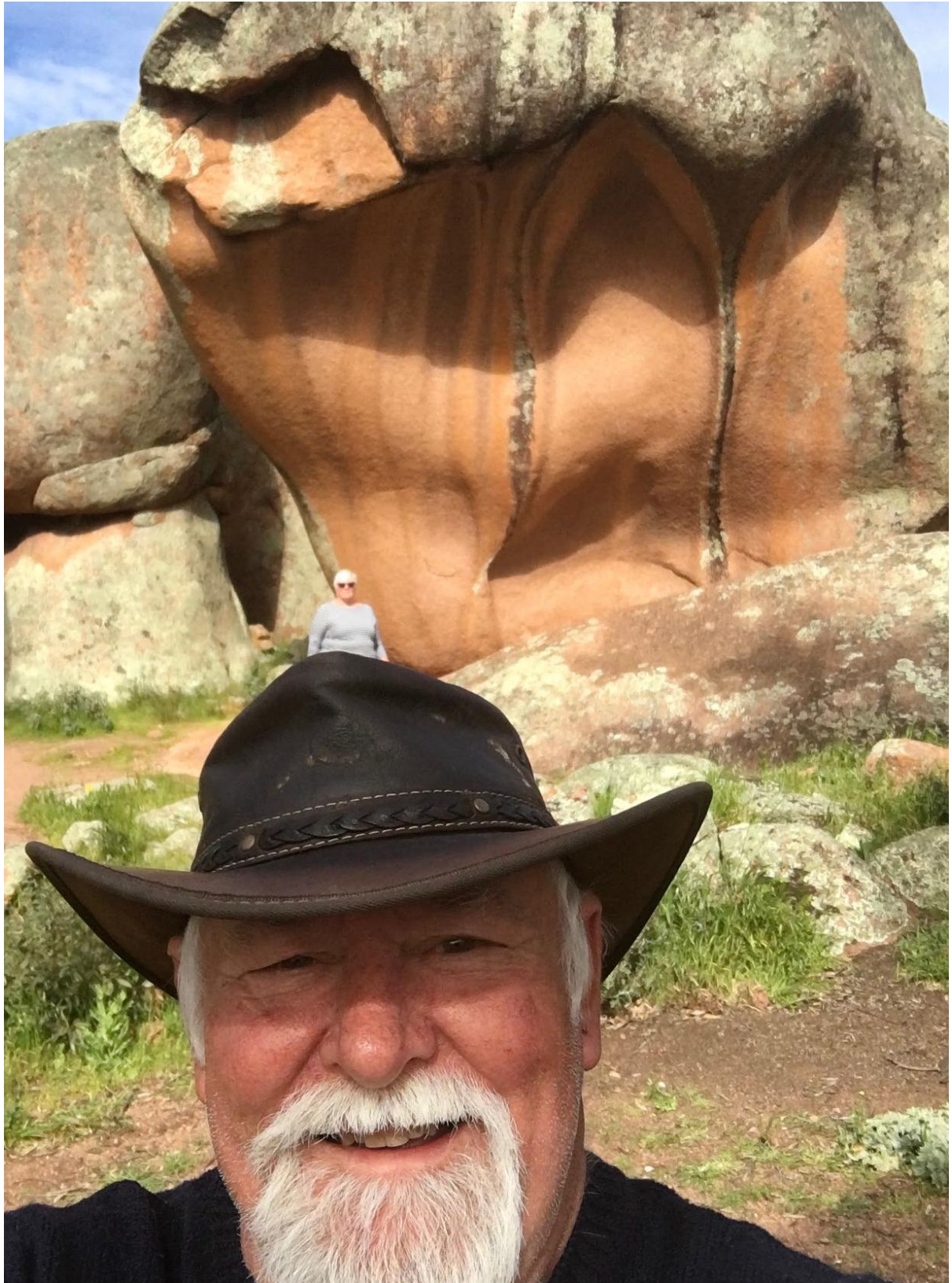

Ron Sinclair Fireman Ron) will be with us again providing great entertainment during the night.

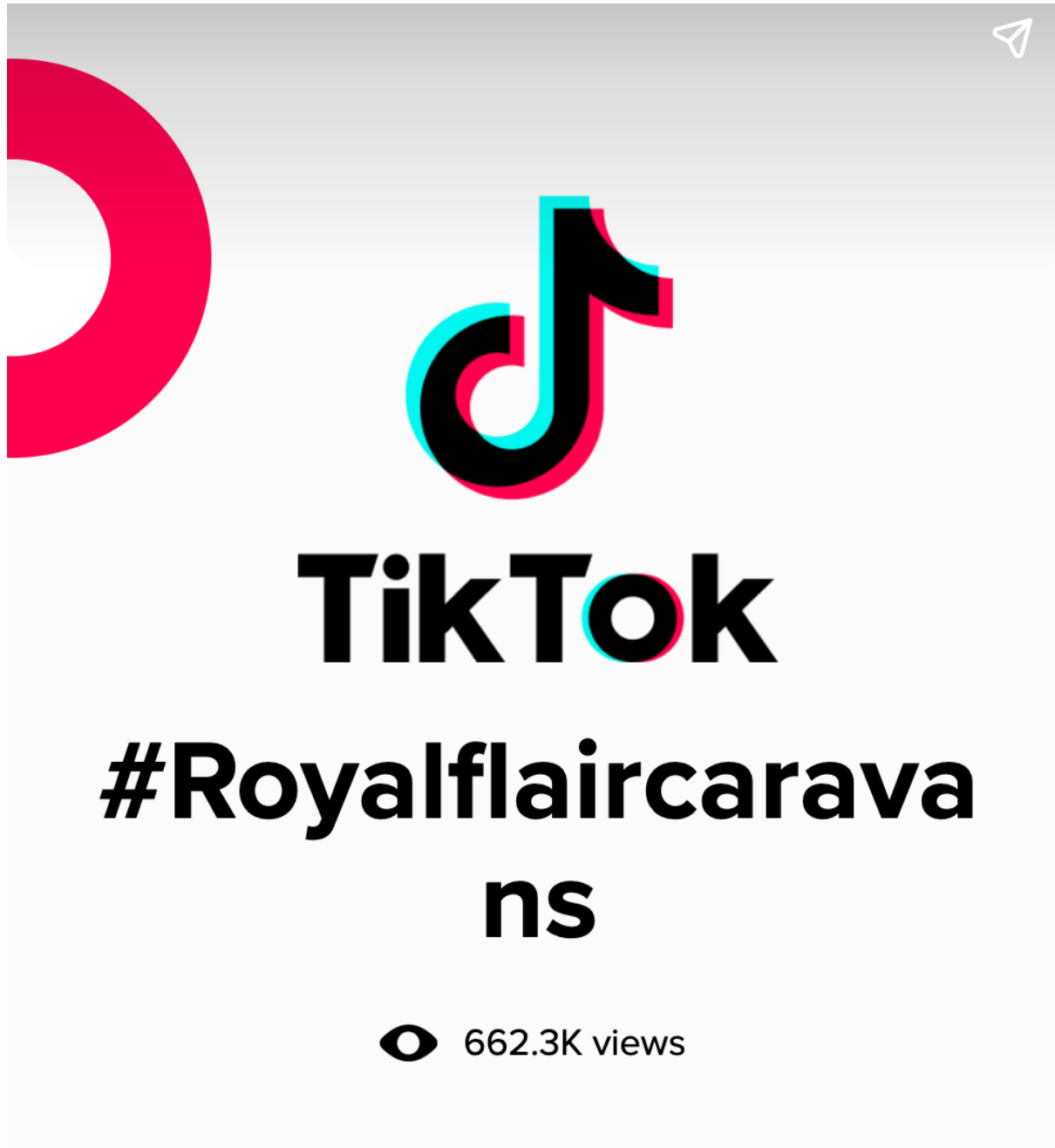
FROM MAX IN MARKETING:
